### 2025 WINTER NETBALL REGISTRATIONS

Public promotion of registrations will commence on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2025. To secure your spot, we encourage members to register promptly as spots will be allocated on a first-come basis.

Here are the key details:

#### Registration Period:

- Opens to the public: Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2025
- Closes: Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2025, or when the grade reaches full capacity

#### Registration Process:

- All members must register through the St. Christopher's PlayHQ website.

#### Additional Requirement:

- Please read and accept the terms and conditions outlined in the 2025 Player and Selection Information document (attached separately).

#### Commitments:

- Consider potential clashes with your schedule, especially during Tuesday afternoons/evenings, which are reserved for Saints training.
- Commitment to trials and allocated training times throughout the season is anticipated.

## 2025 FEES

The PlayHQ system mandates full payment of fees during online registration. Recognising that some members may face challenges meeting this requirement, we encourage you to get in touch with the club Attention: The President, on [Admin@stchristophersnetballwa.com](mailto:Admin@stchristophersnetballwa.com). We are here to explore and provide alternative options to assist you in this situation where possible.

We encourage families to apply for the **Kidsport Funding** offered by the local council (please refer to the section below on Kidsport). This can be done from 1 January 2025.

PlayHQ accepts online payments made by the following methods:

1. Credit card: VISA, MasterCard, American Express, PayPal
2. Debit card: VISA and MasterCard

Any payments processed during participant registration will appear on your credit card or bank statement as being made to 'Play HQ,' as this is the designated payment system for our transactions.

Our fees include the following for 2025 as outlined below:

- Netball Australia, Netball WA (WANA)
- Fremantle Netball Association (FNA)
- Umpiring: for junior and 18&Under grades during the season and finals.
- Club Operational Costs, which includes some of the following:
  - o Property and Equipment (e.g. balls, timers, first aid, bibs, modified goal posts, etc.) and storage costs.
  - o Court hire for each team and electricity for training throughout trials and the season.
- Trophies & Awards
- Coaching and Umpiring Development and support.
- St Christopher's Netball Club Presentation and Awards Wind-up Function.
- **Fees do not include the cost of uniforms or other club and team events.**

- Please note PlayHQ will add compulsory system service on all registrations.
- Netball WA and Fremantle Netball fees have increased by approx. \$10 per person for Opens and Juniors this season.
- Note – in 2024 fees were reduced substantially due to fee discounts covered by the club in our 'Give Back Year'.
- \*\*Opens umpiring will follow the FNA process where each team is responsible for finding and paying an umpire each week.

## Kidsport Funding

This enables eligible Western Australian children aged 5 to 18 years to participate in community sport and recreation by offering them financial assistance of up to \$300 per calendar year (per eligible child) towards club fees. Families may apply to Kidsport for financial assistance towards St Christopher's Netball Club Fees.

***Those considering Kidsport must APPLY for their unique code PRIOR to registering on the St Christopher's PlayHQ website, as you will require the code to be eligible for the discount.***

## Coaching Volunteer Fee Discount (reimbursed during 2025 season):

St Christopher's is a Club run by volunteers and it is an expectation, all our players/members will assist and volunteer in some capacity during the season.

Players / Members who volunteer in coaching will be offered a discount off their registration fees. This discount will take the form of a reimbursement from the club back to the player / member at the end of the season. However, **full payment** of fees is still required on initial registration. The reimbursement discount amount will be determined by the Committee.

## (By-Laws 3.2) Withdrawals

Members choosing to withdraw after completing the registration process are kindly requested to send an email to the club with the Subject: Withdrawal at [admin@stchristophersnetballwa.com](mailto:admin@stchristophersnetballwa.com), specifying the reason for withdrawal. The Club will then assess the timing of the withdrawal and any incurred fees and costs to determine the eligibility for a partial or nil refund. The Club will communicate the outcome to the member accordingly.

**The terms and conditions of withdrawal are:**

- a) **Netball WA** will not issue any refunds to players after the Club has commenced **grading and trials**.

**St Christopher's Netball Club:**

- b) \$100 club fee is non-refundable up until teams are announced.
- c) Refunds will not be granted once players have been officially announced as members of a team.

**Completion of your Registration and Payment of Fees is taken as acceptance of the information outlined in this document as well as the 2025 Player and Selection Information document.**
