

2025 JUDP (FNA) OPEN NOW

The purpose of the Junior Umpire Development program (JUDP) is to support beginner umpires into developing umpiring skills and confidence to umpire.

REQUIREMENTS: You must be turning 14 in 2025, and if you are successful, you must complete the online Rules of Netball Theory and Foundation Umpire Theory exams.

All trials will be held at Fremantle Netball Association where candidates will umpire in a non-threatening environment. Umpires will umpire round robin games of those players trialling for the 2025 Association teams. Umpires will be supervised/coached every game.

Phase 1 trial dates 5:45pm to 8:30pm (TBC): [Cost to trial: \$30 to be paid at the first trial]

Monday 28 th October	Thursday 31 st October

NB: You must attend at least 4 sessions during Phase 1


And at the top end of the pathway, we were proud to see Sophie Eastaugh continuing her netball journey as she was selected and played in the Fever Reserves.
