## Winter Netball Registrations 2023

St Christopher's Netball Club is opening 2023 registrations to **EXISTING** and **NEW** members at the same time, on a first come basis. Members are encouraged to register at your earliest convenience.

Registration will open on **Sunday 8 January 2023, 9.00 am** and close on **Sunday 5 February 2023, 11.00 pm** or when the grade is full. Members are required to be registered through St Christopher's PlayHQ website.

As a condition of all registrations, members must read and accept the information and conditions outlined in the **2023 Player and Selection Information document** (separately attached).

St Christopher's train on **Tuesday afternoons / evening at Fremantle Netball Association**. It is important members consider all other commitments that may clash with Saints training schedules. It is expected that players commit to all trials and their allocated training time throughout the 2023 season. The Club would also like to be aware of additional commitments that may impact Saturday game day to assist team numbers. ### Fees

The PlayHQ system requires **all fees** to be paid in full when registering on-line. The Club will not be offering payment plans to members. Please understand, this is out of our control and governed by Netball Australia.

We encourage families to apply for the Kidsport Funding offered by the local council (please refer to below section on Kidsport Funding). This can be done effective from 1 January 2023.

PlayHQ accepts online payments made by the following methods:

1. Credit card: VISA, MasterCard, American Express
2. Debit card: VISA and MasterCard

All payments made during the participant registration will display as being made to 'Play HQ' on your credit card or bank statement with the payment system.

**Our fees include the following:**

- **Netball Australia, Netball WA (WANA) and Fremantle Netball Association (FNA)**
- **Umpiring:** for all grades during the season and finals.
- **Club Costs**, which includes some of the following:
  - o Property and Equipment (e.g. balls, timers, first aid, bibs, modified goal posts etc) and storage costs.
  - o FNA court hire for each team (no shared courts) and electricity for trainings throughout trials and the season.
  - o Trophies, Awards, Prizes for Quiz night
  - o Social Events, such as quiz night and Club functions
  - o Player, Coach and Umpire Development and support.
- St Christopher's Netball Club Presentation and Awards **Wind-up Function.**
- All Net Set Go participants receive a participant pack – after registration from Netball Australia delivered to the nominated address upon season commencement.
- Fundraising Levy – this is a cost per player in lieu of raffle tickets, cake stalls, chocolate drives and other fundraising items.
- **Fees do not include the cost of uniforms or any organised individual team event.**

Netball WA and Netball Australia fees have increased by \$3 per person.

St Christopher's Netball Club have increased our fees for Umpiring \$5 per person, Club Costs \$3 per person and Windup \$5 per person for Seniors, U17 and Junior A – E players only. These are consistent with increased costs incurred by the Club.

## Kidsport Funding

Enables eligible Western Australian children aged 5 to 18 years to participate in community sport and recreation by offering them financial assistance of up to \$150 per calendar year towards club fees. Families may apply for financial assistance towards St Christopher's Netball Club Fees.

Those considering Kidsport must **APPLY** for their unique code **PRIOR** to registering on the St Christopher's PlayHQ website, as you will require the code to be eligible for the discount.

## Volunteer Fee Discount (reimbursed during season):

St Christopher's is a Club run by volunteers and it is an expectation, all our players /members will be required to volunteer in some capacity during the season.

Players / Members who **volunteer** in roles such as coaching, managing and / or committee, will be offered a discount off their registration fees. This discount will take the form of payment from the club back to the player / member at the end of the season. However, **full payment** of fees is still required on initial registration. The discount amount will be determined by the Committee and is dependent on the volunteer role.

## Withdrawals

Members who decide to withdraw after registering, please email the club stating reason for withdrawal. The Club will advise members whether they are eligible for a partial or nil refund. The refund is dependent on the timing of the withdrawal and if other fees and costs has been incurred.

The terms and conditions of a withdrawal are:

- a. **Netball WA** will not be issuing any refunds to players after the Club has commenced **grading and trials**.
- b. **St Christopher's Netball Club:** \$100 of Club fees is non-refundable up until teams are announced.
- c. Once players have been announced in a team there will be **no refund**
