- This program is a fun introduction netball and where possible we will endeavour to place friends together, please note this on your registration form.
- The NetSetGO pack is to be claimed directly from the Woolworths NetSetGO estore keep an eye out for the email to claim the pack directly.
- Parents must be present for the duration of any session or event that your child attends. If you are unable to be present then you must ensure that there is another trusted adult (not the NetSetGO personnel) that will oversee your child.

FEE INFORMATION

The fees for this program is **\$80.00 for a 3month membership,** made up of the following:

Club Fee - \$24.49 Netball Australia - \$4.49 Netball WA (3 months) - \$51.02*

*Members have the option to choose the 12-month Netball WA fee (\$79.54), if considering playing in any other programs in 2024, this may be a better option (total fees would then be \$108.52).

PlayHQ charge a 1.49% service fee which will be charged at checkout on top of the above.

Withdrawals

Withdrawal information prior to first session, 7 May 2024:

- Netball Australia: (\$4.49) Fee is non-refundable
- Netball WA: **NSG pack (\$31.24) is non-refundable**. The balance of NWA fees is only eligible if withdrawal occurred prior to the first session, Tuesday 7 May. On and/or after the first session, no refund.
- St Christopher's Club Fees: Full club fee minus the stripe fee charge refundable prior to first session (3 month Netball WA eligible for \$22.87 and 12 month Netball WA eligible for \$22.29). On and/or after the first training session, no refund.

Missed sessions

- Due to the program only running for 8 weeks, there will be no makeup dates should members not be able to attend.
- Sessions cancelled by the club due to poor weather will be offered in Term 3.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Consents

I give consent for the player details to be used for player administrative tasks within the Club including the sharing of contact details with coaches, managers and other Club officials. This also includes forwarding information to FNA, Netball WA and Netball Australia for registration purposes.

Medical Information

St Christopher's Netball Club must be notified of any changes to a player's condition that may affect their care during the netball season.

Insurance information

Once members are registered, they are covered by Player Insurance. For insurance purposes and claims to be processed, players/parents must advise your coach if an injury has been sustained.

If an ambulance is required for you or your child to be transported from FNA, the ambulance cost is not covered under the FNA insurance policy. Please ensure you have the appropriate health cover.
